Briefing on Progress of Langat 2 Water Treatment Plant

INTRODUCTION:

The water demand in Selangor and the Federal Territories of Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya (hereinafter referred to as the study area), is expected to exceed that available from sources within the study area in the near future. In recognition of this potential challenge in water supply, the Federal Government has initiated the implementation of Pahang-Selangor interstate raw water transfer scheme. In order to complement this initiative, the Government has now also embarked on the proposed Langat 2 Water Treatment Plant (WTP) and associated distribution works to treat and distribute water that will be received from the interstate raw water transfer scheme.

The Langat 2 Water Supply Project is a major water supply project for the state of Selangor and the Federal Territory of Kuala Lumpur, envisaged to provide the water to the state and federal territory up to year 2025. The raw water source for the Langat 2 Water Supply Project will be from the Pahang-Selangor Raw Water Project (PSRWT Project), is presently undertaken by the Federal Government. The PSRWT Project will convey raw water from the Sg. Semantan in the state of Pahang through a transfer tunnel to the state of Selangor.

The water will be treated at Langat 2 WTP, which will have an ultimate capacity of 2260Mld. The Langat 2 WTP will be developed in two equal phases and each nominal capacity will be 1130Mld. The treated water will be distributed via separate bulk distribution pipelines to the Western Corridor, Northern Corridor and the existing Langat balancing reservoir.

Pengurusan Aset Air Berhad (PAAB) as the owner of the project has appointed a consortium of consultants led by SMHB Sdn Bhd in association with Ranhill Consulting Sdn Bhd and KTA Tenaga Sdn Bhd (CSRK) to carry out the engineering study, design and supervision of the construction of Phase 1 of the Langat 2 WTP and the distribution works.

The Project will be implemented in various packages and scheduled to be completed by 2017.
