INTRODUCTION

There has been numerous attempts to address the issue of Grease and FOGs (Fats, Oil and Grease) discharge into the main drainage system and polluting the drains, rivers and ultimately creating numerous issues on waste water management and health within the community.

MPSJ and MBSA have looked into this area of pollution which up to date has not been fully resolved in spite of enforcing policies on having grease traps installed in all restaurants and eateries within the country.

Issues faced mainly from FOGs emanating from either restaurants or all eateries are:

- **Presence of bad odor from the grease traps n drains**
- **Clogged pipes resulting in high maintenance costs**
- **Clogged drains from grease or oil & fats discharged**
- **Grease traps are currently maintained only by skimming and the grease still eventually ended up being either discarded at landfills or worse in our river system.**
- **Health is an issue as the bad odor attracts rats which may spread the disease of leptospirosis, respiratory infections, gastro intestinal disorder etc...**
